March 26th: H-2B Wage Final Rule Update: Delay of Effective Date.

The Department of Labor is delaying the effective date of the Wage Methodology for Temporary Non-agricultural Employment H-2B Program final rule (the Wage Rule) in order to address legislation that prohibits any funds from being used to implement the Wage Rule for the remainder of FY 2013. The attached notice has been sent to the Federal Register for posting and publication.

The Department of Labor will publish a notice in the Federal Register delaying the effective date of the Wage Methodology for the Temporary Non-agricultural Employment H-2B Program final rule (2011 Wage Final Rule), which was published on January 19, 2011, 76 FR 3452. In light of the anticipated enactment of the Consolidated and Further Continuing Appropriations Act, 2013, which establishes the Department's appropriations through September 30, 2013, and also continues the prohibition of the expenditure of the Department's appropriated funds to implement, administer, and enforce the 2011 Wage Final Rule, the Department will delay the effective date of the 2011 Wage Final Rule.
