On January 18, 2011, President Obama issued Executive Order 13563, which outlines several principles to improve regulation and regulatory review. Read the [Executive Order](#) and two related Memoranda on [Regulatory Compliance](#) and [Regulatory Flexibility, Small Business and Job Creation](#).

The Executive Order outlines several guiding principles for Federal agencies to follow in their regulations, such as ensuring that an agency's regulations:

- Take into account costs and benefits to society
- Are based on the best available science
- Are developed in a manner that allows public participation
- Are accessible, consistent, and written in plain language
- Use the least burdensome methods to achieve regulatory goals

The Executive Order also requires agencies to consider how to promote the analysis of existing significant regulations that may be outmoded, ineffective, insufficient, or excessively burdensome. To facilitate our
