## USCIS Reaches H-2B Cap for First Half of Fiscal Year 2026

U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services has received enough petitions to meet the congressionally established <u>H-2B cap</u> for the first half of fiscal year 2026. Sept. 12 was the final receipt date for new capsubject H-2B worker petitions requesting an employment start date before April 1, 2026. We will reject new cap-subject H-2B petitions we receive after Sept. 12, that request an employment start date before April 1, 2026.
