All customers filing a Form I-290B should check the Direct Filing Address for I-290B web page for filing instructions. Do not submit Form I-290B directly to the Administrative Appeals Office. Please note: if you are filing based on a Form I-730, Refugee/Asylee Relative Petition, where you file depends on whether the unfavorable decision was made by a USCIS service center or a USCIS international field office. If the unfavorable decision was made by a USCIS service center, you will file the Form I-290B with the Phoenix Lockbox. If the unfavorable decision was made by a USCIS international field office, you will file the Form I-290B with the Dallas Lockbox. Remember, the wrong help can hurt!
