**AMICUS INVITATION (Office of the Chief Administrative Hearing Officer –
Employer Sanctions)**

DUE August 10, 2023.

In connection with a remand from the Chief Administrative Hearing Officer (CAHO), the Chief Administrative Law Judge (CALJ) welcomes interested members of the public to file amicus curiae briefs discussing the below issue.

ISSUE PRESENTED:

When an employer is liable for 8 U.S.C. § 1324a violations that occurred after November 2, 2015, what date of assessment should be used to calculate the inflation-adjusted penalty ranges? *See* 28 C.F.R. § 85.5; 28 C.F.R. § 68.52(c)(8); 28 C.F.R. § 85.1.

Filing a Brief: Your filing should include a case caption containing the following information:

- The statutory provision under which the proceeding is instituted: 8 U.S.C. § 1324a;
- The docket number assigned by the Office of the Chief Administrative Hearing Officer (OCAHO): 2020A00050
- The names of all parties to the case: United States of America, Complainant; Edgemont Group, LLC, Respondent; and
- A designation of the type of filing being submitted (e.g., Brief of Amicus Curiae).

Amici may wish to consult any of the prior published decisions in this case, 17 OCAHO no. 1470b (2023) *et ant.*, on the Office of the Chief Administrative Hearing Officer's website for examples of how this case caption typically appears. *See* <https://www.justice.gov/eoir/listing-volume-17-decisions>.

Your filing should also include Amicus Invitation No. 23-13-07 at the top of the first page. Your filing should be limited to a legal discussion of the issue presented. The CALJ will not consider a brief that exceeds the scope of the amicus invitation, and the decision whether to accept an amicus brief is within her sole discretion. Collaborating amici should submit a joint amicus brief rather than filing separate submissions.

Request for Case Information: Additional information about the case may be found in the prior published decisions in this case, 17 OCAHO no. 1470 (2022) *et seq.*, on the Office of the Chief Administrative Hearing Officer's website. *See* <https://www.justice.gov/eoir/listing-volume-17-decisions>. Page Limit: Amicus curiae briefs are limited to 25 double-spaced, properly paginated pages.

Deadline: Amicus curiae briefs must be filed by August 10, 2023. Briefs must be received in OCAHO by the stated deadline.

OCAHO Filing Address and Procedures: All briefs related to this solicitation must be filed by facsimile or same-day delivery, or if such filing or service cannot be made, by overnight delivery. If a brief is sent by facsimile, the filer must also concurrently send a hard copy of the brief to OCAHO.
