Electronic Crewman's Landing Permits, Form I-95

- Beginning July 1, 2026, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) will start issuing electronic Crewman's Landing Permits, Form I-95.
- CBP will create a new, electronic I-95 for each encounter. As such, there will be no need to "reuse" the electronic form, as is currently done with the paper I-95.
- Crewmembers will be able to display an electronic I-95 on a smart device or print the I-95 from either the [I-94/I-95 website](#) or the [CBP Link](#) mobile application.
- Only the most recently issued electronic I-95 will be available for crewmembers to retrieve.
- CBP may continue to issue paper I-95s at locations where data connectivity is an issue. Owners, masters, and agents should coordinate with the local port regarding whether a paper I-95 will be required.
