Statement of Unavailable Identity Evidence	A statement as to why none of the requested identity evidence is available for submission.



USCIS ELIS Webinars



On May 22, 2012, U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) launched the first phase of our new electronic immigration system, known as USCIS ELIS. This initial release brings the agency closer to realizing the web-based future of immigration services. Currently, USCIS ELIS is available for certain students and visitors who need to file a stand-alone Application to Extend/Change Nonimmigrant Status (Form I-539). Future releases will add form types and functions to the system, gradually expanding to cover all USCIS immigration benefits.
