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EOIR to Close Batavia Immigration Court

FALLS CHURCH, VA – The Executive Office for Immigration Review (EOIR) announced today that the Batavia Immigration Court, located within the Department of Homeland Security's (DHS) Buffalo (Batavia) Service Processing Center, will close at the close of business on July 24, 2026. DHS is unable to continue providing space for court operations.

All pending cases will be transferred to the Buffalo Immigration Court and will be heard via video teleconference. EOIR will provide official advance notice to all parties whose cases are reassigned to the Buffalo Immigration Court.

All pleadings, motions, and other correspondence for cases currently assigned to the Batavia Immigration Court should be filed with the Buffalo Immigration Court beginning July 27, 2026. EOIR recommends including the notation: "Attention – Former Batavia Immigration Court case" on the first page of any such filing.
