NSC Flash #4-2004

Guidance for USC I-130 petitioners whose spouse/child is in the U.S. on a K visa

This flash message is an advisory for United States citizen petitioners who have an I-130 pending at the NSC for a spouse or a child under age 21 where the spouse or child has arrived in the States on a K-3 or K-4 visa. Under these circumstances, the petitioner should advise the NSC that the beneficiary is now in the U.S. by forwarding both a copy of the receipt notice for the I-130 and a copy of the beneficiary's I-94 showing that s/he arrived as a K-3/K-4 to:

Once the Center is notified that the beneficiary is in the U.S., the NSC will process him/her for adjustment of status in the U.S. rather than consular processing. Note: the petitioner should also provide the current address of the beneficiary(ies).
