U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) will hold a stakeholder briefing for Afghan nationals who came to the United States under Operation Allies Welcome/Enduring Welcome, and the organizations that provide support to them. The Afghan Support Center is part of the U.S. Government's ongoing commitment to Afghan nationals and brings together federal, state, and local government agencies and organizations that provide a wide range of services, including legal and resettlement support. The Afghan Support Center in Northern Virginia is the 13th center since USCIS began the initiative in May 2023.
